**KCA website**

- Need Board members to help work on website

**Pavilion Electrical work**

- Electrical permit approved, Ed Tsuchiyama anticipate completion by April 14. All fixtures purchased and ready for installation once inspection approved
- Noted in invoices that insulation was planned for building. Ordered and paid to Honsador. 4/10 S/W Sam, will cancel insulation except for office space and request reimbursement

**State GIA 2015-16**

- 3rd invoice and final report submitted to DHHL for final payment of \$60,000 from 2016 GIA

**State GIA 2017-18**

- ED provided testimony 3/17 to share project with all Legislators.
- ED had face to face interview with finance committee 3/25 in Waimea for GIA request of 2.75M
- GIA funding decision expected at end of April
- Met with land planner 4/8-will provide quote for culvert and land plans, topo maps, etc

**Ho'okupa'a conference** March 27-28, UH law school.

- ED attended conference, site visits and dinner w/ NMTC investors
- Offer on table of 5M allocation w/net of 1.5M by Travois from Chickasaw Nation
- Site visit by investors to Honokoa did not occur due to limited time
- KCA Received \$200 travel grant for conference from HCF
- Balance of Travel cost for airfare, hotel, car request to be reimbursed when funds available

**FireWise**

- Approved for \$500 grant to do May 6 , National fuel reduction day-hired TreeWorks to go thorough community and mulch and remove all green/dry waste the community puts out for pick up
- Ola volunteered to help load materials into chipper/truck. Other volunteers are welcome

**Water**

- Working with Judy from RWA to find additional funding source-No movement
- LOS for well on community site received signed by the Dir. of DHHL, No movement on permit
- COH grant for brackish water well -NOT funded-cannot fund CIP projects on this grant

**Stream diversions:**

- Tim Richards need to find time to meet with KCA. Will continue to reach out to schedule meeting
- ED Attended Legal workshop on water rights
- Working with OHA Rep. Shane Nelson to have Law school students look at all paperwork and determine if legal action is appropriate. Other HHL communities interested in class action suit to get DHHL to do their due diligence to provide communities with the water they need

**COH GIA-Aquaponic project 2015-16, 2016-17**

- Tanks, pumps, liner, air-lines received
- Need to put together one test system
- Only 5 applications for community system received

**Ungulate proof fence Project by KC**

- Archeology review by SHPD needs to be done before KC can proceed

**Grants applications status**

- COH non-profit grant-brackish well -ED attended the COH non-profit grant interview for \$100,000 for well development 3/13, decisions to be made in April-NOT funded as it was classified as a CIP
- USDA community Grant-\$50,000 -not yet submitted
- HCF Restoration grant-working on

- NFWF restoration grant-Julia Rose TNC helped w/grant-submitted
- OHA Ahahui-Ed working on it
- HCF FLEX-ED working on it
- FireWise fuel reduction grant-submitted by ED-hire Kohala Center (KC) to do fuel break on northern border while they do fence-line
- KABOOM-play video (\$20,000)-Easton Chong volunteered to work on play video. Mele McPherson agreed to kokua Easton if needed
